LICENSING OF ELECTRICIANS

125.01 LICENSE REQUIRED. It is unlawful, except as hereinafter provided, for any person to install, erect, alter, repair, service or replace thereto any electrical system, unless said person first obtains a license pursuant to this chapter. Any person who obtains a license as an authorized representative of a firm or corporation may not apply for permits for more than one person, and the permit shall apply only to the type of work pertaining to the specific license possessed by the holder of the license. It is unlawful, except as hereinafter provided, for any person to install, erect, alter, repair, service or replace thereto any electrical system unless the work is done by a licensed electrician. Said licensed electrician shall be allowed to be assisted by up to three (3) non-licensed helpers working directly under the licensee's supervision.

125.02 EXAMINATIONS. Anyone desiring an electrician's license in the City, who does not hold a current license issued by another municipality whose electrical code is consistent with the Electrical Code of the City, shall take an examination conducted by the Board of Electrical Examiners to show his or her qualifications and pass the examination with a seventy-five percent (75%) score.

125.03 LICENSE AND EXAMINATION FEES. License fees for electrical contractors, electrical appliance licenses, and electrician's license and examination fees for electrical licenses are set by resolution of the Council. All licenses shall be in effect from January 1 through December 31 of each year.

125.04 RESPONSIBILITIES OF LICENSE HOLDERS. License holders are responsible for the work performed by their employees as covered by their license. Electrical contractors performing work shall also be required to hold a current electrician's license. An electrical appliance license allows the holder of such license and said holder's employees to repair or install from the electrical source any appliance defined as such in the *National Electrical Code*. Every holder of a license or certificate shall keep his or her license or certificate displayed in a conspicuous place in said license holder's place of business at all times.
