Walker/Loftus to approve the June 18, 2013 agenda. Ayes-Three. Motion carried.

Hibben/Loftus to approve Yard Waste contract with the city of Elk Run Heights. The Mayor stated that the last time Council discussed the contracts; it was decided to monitor the City's costs associated with the Yard Waste Center. He added that there are provisions built into the contracts to protect the City from increased costs during storm events, however there haven't been any recent increases in expenditures associated with the Center. 
