

ORDINANCE 618

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF EVANSDALE, IOWA, BY AMENDING PROVISIONS PERTAINING TO THE DIVISION OF WARDS.

BE IT ENACTED by the City Council of the City of Evansdale, Iowa:

SECTION 1. SECTION MODIFIED. Section 3.02 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Evansdale, Iowa, is repealed and the following adopted in lieu thereof not effective until January 15, 2012:

3.02 DIVISION INTO WARDS. The City is divided into four (4) wards and precincts described as follows: (Unless stated otherwise, all boundaries lie along the centerline of the roadway).

THE FIRST WARD and PRECINCT is described as follows: Beginning at the intersection of the Northern City Boundary and the West City Boundary, thence south along the West City Boundary, thence southeast along the western extension of Leonard Avenue to River Forest Road, thence southwest along River Forest Road to Central Avenue, thence east along Central Avenue to Home Acres Avenue, thence south along Home Acres Avenue to Brookside Avenue, thence east along Brookside Avenue to Grand Boulevard, thence north along Grand Boulevard to Central Avenue, thence west along Central Avenue to Boelling Avenue, thence north along Boelling Avenue to Morris Avenue, thence west along Morris Avenue to Marshall Avenue, thence north along Marshall Avenue to East End Avenue, thence west along East End Avenue to Evans Road, thence north along Evans Road until Evans Road becomes North Evans Road at Lafayette Road, thence north along North Evans Road to the Northern City Boundary. Thence west along the Northern City Boundary to the point of beginning.

THE SECOND WARD and PRECINCT is described as follows: Beginning at the intersection of the western extension of Leonard Avenue and the West City Boundary, thence following southwesterly, southerly, southeasterly, northeasterly, along the City Boundary to the Evansdale Nature Trail, thence north along the Evansdale Nature Trail to River Road, thence east, northwest along River Road to Sixth Street, thence west along Sixth Street until it becomes Grand Boulevard, thence north along Grand Boulevard to Brookside Avenue, thence west along Brookside Avenue to Home Acres Avenue, thence north along Home Acres Avenue to Central Avenue, thence west along Central Avenue to River Forest Road, thence north along River Forest Road to Leonard Avenue. Thence west along Leonard Avenue to the point of beginning.

THE THIRD WARD and PRECINCT is described as follows: Beginning at the intersection of the Northern City Boundary and North Evans Road, thence south along North Evans Road until North Evans Road becomes Evans Road at Lafayette Road, thence south along Evans Road to East End Avenue, thence east along East End Avenue to Marshall Avenue, thence south along Marshall Avenue to Morris Avenue, thence east along Morris Avenue to Boelling Avenue, thence south along Boelling Avenue to Central Avenue, thence east along Central Avenue to South Roosevelt Road, thence north along South Roosevelt Road to Lafayette Road, thence southeasterly along Lafayette Road to the East City Boundary, thence due north along the East City Boundary, and thence east along the East City Boundary to the Northern City Boundary. Thence northwesterly along the Northern City Boundary to the point of beginning.

THE FOURTH WARD and PRECINCT is described as follows: Beginning at the point where Elk Run Creek flows under Lafayette Road, thence northwest along Lafayette Road to South Roosevelt Road, thence south along South Roosevelt Road to Central Avenue, thence west along Central Avenue to Grand Boulevard, thence south along Grand Boulevard to Sixth Street, thence east along Sixth Street to River Road, thence southeast and then south and then west along River Road to the Evansdale Nature Trail, thence south along the extension of the Evansdale Nature Trail to the South City Boundary at the Cedar River, thence southeasterly and then east along the South City Boundary to the East City Boundary, thence north along to East City Boundary to

Gilbertville Road, thence northwesterly along Gilbertville Road to the Elk Run Heights border; thence along the City Boundary west, south, and west to McCoy Road, then north along McCoy Road to the intersection of the east-west leg of the City Boundary, following the City Boundary in a clockwise manor to McCoy Road, thence northeasterly on McCoy Road to Lafayette Road. Thence west along Lafayette Road to the point of the beginning.

SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, provision, or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision, or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 3. WHEN EFFECTIVE. This ordinance shall be in effect starting January 15, 2012.
