

ORDINANCE 627

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF EVANSDALE, IOWA, THAT BY AMENDING PROVISIONS PERTAINING TO FIREWORKS REGULATIONS.

BE IT ENACTED by the City Council of the City of Evansdale, Iowa:

SECTION 1. SUBSECTION MODIFIED. Subsection 41.13 (2) of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Evansdale, Iowa is repealed and the following adopted in lieu thereof:

41.13 (2) FIREWORKS. Regulations. It is unlawful for any person to offer for sale, expose for sale, sell at retail, or use or explode any fireworks; provided the City may, upon application in writing, grant a permit for the display of fireworks by a City agency, fair associations, amusement parks and other organizations or groups of individuals approved by City authorities when such fireworks display will be handled by a competent operator. No permit shall be granted hereunder unless the operator or sponsoring organization has filed with the City evidence of insurance in the following amounts:

- A. Personal Injury: \$500,000 per person
- B. Property Damage: \$100,000
- C. Total Exposure: \$5,000,000

(Code of Iowa, Sec. 727.2)

SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, provision, or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision, or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.


SECTION 3. WHEN EFFECTIVE. This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its final passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.



SECTION 1, SUBSECTION MODIFIED
Subsection 41.13 (2) of the Code of Or-
dinances of the City of Evansdale, Iowa
is repealed and the following adopted in
lieu thereof:
41.13 (2) FIREWORKS, Regulations. It
is unlawful for any person to offer for
sale, expose for sale, sell at retail, or use
or explode any fireworks; provided the
City may, upon application in writing,
grant a permit for the display of fireworks
by a City agency, fair, associations,
amusement parks and other organiza-
tions or groups of individuals approved
by City authorities when such fireworks
display will be handled by a competent
operator. No permit shall be granted
hereunder unless the operator or spon-
soring organization has filed with the City
evidence of insurance in the following
amounts:
Personal Injury: \$500,000 per person;
Property Damage: \$100,000. Total Ex-
posure: \$5,000,000.
SECTION 2, SEVERABILITY CLAUSE.
If any section, provision, or part of this
ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or
unconstitutional, such adjudication shall
not affect the validity of the ordinance as
a whole or any section, provision, or part
thereof not so adjudged invalid or
unconstitutional.
SECTION 3, WHEN EFFECTIVE. This
ordinance shall be in effect from and af-
ter its final passage, approval, and pub-
lication as provided by law.
